



Lattof YMCA Financial Assistance Policies

When applying for financial assistance, all participants must apply to Action for Children, the state funding program, before they can be approved for Lattof YMCA camp scholarships.

Your child must have a valid YMCA membership at the time of registration until September 1st, in order to receive membership rates of YMCA scholarships.

All parents are required to pay a \$20 deposit per week per child in order to hold their spots in camp. There are non-transferable and non-refundable.

When waiting for the approval or denial from Action for Children, parents must pay in full for camp until they receive their response from the program.

We do not provide Lattof YMCA scholarships for Specialty Camps.

When you participate in Action for Children:

- Completing the Action for Children paperwork is completely the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- All parents must put down \$20 deposits. These will be applied to the co-payment amount for the weeks that they attend if the child is a member of the YMCA.
- If your child/ren has a valid membership during the camping season, the difference between the amount camp costs and the amount the state provides will be scholarshiped.
- If your child/ren does not have a valid membership during the camping season, you will be responsible for the difference between the cost of camp and the amount Action for Children provides.
- When participating in Specialty camps at the Lattof YMCA, parents are responsible for the difference between the price of Traditional Day Camp and the specialty camp. Ex. Traditional day camp costs \$165 and a specialty camp costs \$200. The parent would be responsible for \$35 and their monthly co-payment.
